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RISKS OF FUNCTIONAL SINUS ENDOSCOPIC SURGERY

The risks of Functional Endoscopic Sinus Surgery have been discussed with patient: _____

Including the following:

- 1. Bleeding, which may occur in the immediate postoperative period or as late as two to three weeks after surgery.**
- 2. Recurrent or persistent infection.**
- 3. Scar tissue formation.**
- 4. Cerebral spinal fluid leak.**
- 5. Meningitis.**
- 6. Vision loss that may occur from hemorrhage into or around the optic nerve.**
- 7. Nasolacrimal duct injury (duct that goes from the eye to the nose).**
